MEMORIAL HALL

Works underway. Extension to the north. Renovations and alterations to the interior. Funding from Sugarloaf Pipeline Regional Benefits \$452,381 & VBAF \$448,000

YARRA GLEN REGIONAL PLAYGROUND

Proposed new playground in McKenzie Reserve. Works planned to commence soon. Funding from numerous sources \$540,000

SKATE PARK

Upgrade works still in progress. Funding by SPRB \$90,000

GARY COOPER PAVILION (Big Green Shed)

Yarra Ranges Council plans to modify the internal space to accommodate the Men's Shed. The remainder will become a half size basketball court.

STEELS CREEK WALKING TRACK

Planning is underway for the construction of the Yarra Glen to Steels Creek Walking Track. Funding from Victorian Bushfire Appeal Fund \$675,625

STEELS CREEK COMMUNITY CENTRE

Renovation and extension works have commenced. Funding from Sugarloaf Pipeline Regional Benefits \$200,000 & insurance payment of \$65,000.

STEELS CREEK TENNIS CLUB

New clubrooms open this month. Funding from Sugarloaf Pipeline Regional Benefits and Yarra Ranges Council. \$98,000

DIXONS CREEK RESERVE

The Dixons Creek community is working on a redevelopment of the Dixons Creek Reserve facilities. Funding from Sugarloaf Pipeline Regional Benefits \$250,000. Auspiced by YG&DTGInc.

BYPASS & ROUNDABOUT

This project is nearing completion with most of the roadwork completed. We look forward to the landscaping on and around the Bell St roundabout, which should enhance the entrance to our town. A \$15,000,000 project.

YARRA GLEN RAILWAY STATION

The Yarra Valley Railway is now rebuilding the track from Yarra Glen towards Healesville. The first stage is up to Train Trak Vineyard/Simpsons La. Limited funding has become available for works on the Yarra Glen Station. A Public Meeting will be held in June to inform the community of the project. Details soon!

RECREATION RESERVE

Commencement of works has been delayed due to the wet ground conditions. Works include pavilion upgrade, netball courts, parking and toilet upgrades. Some track works have been completed. Funding from various sources \$850,000.

YARRA GLEN WALKING TRACK

Completed late last year, the track completes a loop around Yarra Glen. It runs along Glenview Rd and King St between Symonds St and Yarraview Rd. Funding from Sugarloaf Pipeline Regional Benefits \$232,000. Auspiced and project managed by YG&DTGInc. Project completed for \$114,000. Remaining funds returned to the Alliance for allocation to other projects.

YARRA GLEN BOWLS CLUB

The Bowling Club has recently obtained funding for improvements and to build another bowling green to the south of the Clubrooms. Funding from Sugarloaf Pipeline Alliance \$ 350,000.
